Yolo County YMCA Early Learning Program Qualifications

Enrollment into the Yolo County Early Learning Program is determined by specific family eligibility **and** need criteria. In addition, a child's parent must live in California. Families must complete an application and provide documentation of eligibility to enroll. Families will complete a certification process at initial enrollment and must recertify their eligibility every 24 months thereafter.

Ages 6 weeks - 5 years old

 - Income
 - Current CalWORKs Cash-Aid Recipient
 - Receiving Benefits from Certain Governmental Programs
 - Homelessness

- Need for services
 - Child Protective Services
 - At-Risk of abuse, neglect, or exploitation
 - Employed or Self-Employed
 - Seeking Employment
 - Seeking Permanent Housing
 - Homelessness
 - Vocational Training
 - Educational Program
 - Incapacitated
